
SUSTAINABILITY DUTCH GRAND PRIX

DISCOVER ALL TRANSPORT OPTIONS

PARK & BIKE

Bike together through the beautiful nature to the Dutch Grand Prix. Park the car in the specially designed Park & Bike parking lots in the Zandvoort region. Cycle from there on to the circuit in about 30 minutes.

After a wonderful bike ride, you can store your bike for free at a bicycle storage within walking distance of the circuit. Also, it's possible to park your bike in one of the supervised bicycle parking facilities for a small fee. You can bring your own bicycle or rent a bicycle/e-bike. A bicycle can be rented in advance or on site at the Park & Bike parking lot.

There is also the option to create your own package, allowing you to invite your own guests and bike together to the Dutch Grand Prix. Please contact sales@mobian.global in this case.

- **Bike rental:** from €25,- per bike per day
- **E-bike rental, incl. secured bicycle parking spot:** from €41,- per e-bike per day

Do you want to travel to Zandvoort comfortably? Travel with the Dutch Grand Prix Shuttle to Zandvoort and board near your hometown or place of residence. With a guaranteed seat, no transfers, a fixed arrival and departure time and a drop-off 400 meters from the circuit, the Dutch Grand Prix Shuttle is one of the best travel options to Zandvoort.

PUBLIC BUS TRANSPORT

Public bus transport is the best option for anyone who lives or stays in the Amstelland region (Amstelveen, Uithoorn, Aalsmeer) and Haarlemmermeer. It is also a direct and comfortable transport option for visitors coming from Amsterdam South and Southeast.

During the entire race weekend, bus lines 300 and 356 run directly from Haarlem Station to the entrance of the circuit. Connexion runs on average between 10 and 12 times per hour, so you never have to wait long for the next bus. View the main bus lines and transfers towards Zandvoort and buy a bus ticket in advance.

 *Children up to 11 years old travel for free when accompanied by an adult with a valid bus ticket

TRAIN

The Formula 1 Heineken Dutch Grand Prix is the only Grand Prix in the world with a train station within walking distance from the circuit.

During the Dutch Grand Prix, a large number of extra trains will be available and used. This way traveling to the Zandvoort aan Zee station is quick and easy. Ten-thousands of fans will be walking down the boulevard toward the circuit entrance, which is an experience in itself.

Plan your train journey in advance and consult the NS App shortly before departure for the most up-to-date travel information.

PARK + RIDE

During the Formula 1 Heineken Dutch Grand Prix, Zandvoort and surrounding municipalities are not accessible by car or motorcycle due to a lack of parking options. A better option is to choose one of the sustainable transport options. During the race weekend, the roads to Zandvoort are closed from Thursday 5:00 AM to Sunday 11:00 PM.

Do you still want to go to the Dutch Grand Prix by car? Park your car or motorcycle in Q-Park Mahler (Amsterdam Zuidas), Q-Park Buitenplein (Amstelveen), Q-Park Handelsplein (Amstelveen) or Q-Park Spaarne Gasthuis (Hoofddorp). From these parking spaces you continue your journey with public bus transport from Connexxion and you will be dropped off within walking distance of the circuit.

Tickets

- **Parking + public bus transport to circuit: €49,-**
For this rate you can park 1 car and ride the bus with a maximum of 5 people
