




## FORMULA 1 HEINEKEN DUTCH GRAND PRIX




### GOAL: 100% sustainable transportation

## PARK & BIKE

Take a joint bike ride through te beautiful nature to the Dutch Grand Prix. Park your car at the designated Park & Bike parking areas in the Zandvoort region. From there, bike to the circuit in approximately 30 minutes.

After a beautiful bike ride you can store your bike for free in a bicycle shed within walking distance of the circuit. It is also possible to store your bike in a monitored bike shed for a small fee. You can bring your own bike or rent a bike/e-bike.

You can rent a bike both in advance and on-site at the Park & Bike location. We recommend renting a bike in advance so that it is ready for you upon arrival. Bikes are also available for rent on-site, while stocks last.

Additionally, it is possible to create a fully customized arrangement, allowing you to welcome your guests and travel together by bike to the Dutch Grand Prix. For more information, please contact sales@mobian.global.

### **DUTCH GRAND PRIX** SHUTTLE

Looking for a comfortable way to travel to Zandvoort? With the Dutch Grand Prix Shuttle, you can board nearby and travel directly to the circuit without transfers. The cost of a ticket depends on the distance you need to travel, but prices start from €30,-.

With this travel option, you'll enjoy:

- Choice of ±140 boarding locations across the Netherlands.
- Fixed arrival and departure times.
- Guaranteed seating.
- Travel to the circuit without a transfer, with up to 4 stops.
- Drop-off and departure point at Boulevard Barnaart, within walking distance of the circuit.
- Buses are equipped with a toilet and climate control.

Do you travel with 14 or more people from the same location? Then, in consultation with Pouw Vervoer, an additional boarding point can be added to the map.

## **PRIVATE COACH TRANSPORTATION**

- Coach parking ticket for Thursday, 28 August\*\*: €200,-\* per ticket per day
- **P1 coach parking ticket (parking only)\*\*:** from €450,-\* per ticket per day
- **P2 coach parking ticket (double parking)\*\*:** from €275,-\* per ticket per day
- Kiss & Ride ticket for coach on Thursday, 28 August\*\*: from €150,-\* per day round trip
- Kiss & Ride Mini Bus ticket (12 20 pax)\*\*: from €180,-\* per day per round-trip
- **Kiss & Ride ticket for coach\*\*:** from €200\* per day per round-trip

## **PUBLIC BUS TRANSPORT**

Public bus transportation is the best option for anyone living or staying in the Amstelland region (Amstelveen, Uithoorn, Aalsmeer) and Haarlemmermeer. It is also a direct and comfortable transport option from Amsterdam-Zuid and Zuidoost.

During the entire race weekend, bus lines 300 and 356 run directly from Haarlem Station to the entrance of the circuit. Connexxion operates on average between 10 and 12 times per hour, so you won't have to wait long for the next bus.

In addition to the OV-chip card, you can now also check in and out with OVpay. This allows you to travel easily with your contactless debit card, credit card, or mobile phone (with a digital card). No registration or balance top-up is required, as the travel costs will be automatically deducted from your account. Please note: American Express is not accepted. Prefer to buy your bus ticket in advance? That's of course also possible.

#### Tickets

• **Dutch Grand Prix Day Ticket:** from €12,50\* per person.

\* Children up to 11 years old can travel for free when accompanied by an adult with a valid bus ticket.

## TRAIN

Zandvoort aan Zee station is within walking distance of Circuit Zandvoort, making the train a popular travel option for visitors. Especially for the event weekend, extra trains are being deployed, allowing you to travel to Zandvoort quickly and easily. Once you arrive, join the tens of thousands of other race fans and walk along the lively boulevard to the circuit. A unique experience!

However, please keep in mind that it can be extremely crowded before and after the event. Despite the extra trains, waiting times at departure may reach up to 60 minutes.

Therefore, stay a bit longer at the event site until the biggest crowds have cleared, and enjoy your favorite artist in the Fanzone or explore the lively atmosphere in Zandvoort. Another option is the Dutch Grand Prix Shuttle (page 9), ideal if you prefer a fixed arrival and departure time. Or take the bike and use the Park & Bike option (page 7).

#### Tickets

- Buy your train ticket online in advance or check in with your OV chip card. In addition to the OV-chip card, you can now also check in and out with OVpay. This allows you to travel easily with your contactless debit card, credit card, or mobile phone (with a digital card). No registration or balance top-up is required, as the travel costs will be automatically deducted from your account. Please note: American Express is not accepted.

## PARK + RIDE

During the Dutch Grand Prix, Zandvoort and surrounding municipalities will be inaccessible by car or motorcycle due to a lack of parking spaces. A better option is to choose one of the sustainable transportation options. Throughout the race weekend, the roads leading to Zandvoort will be closed until Monday, September 1 at 5:00 AM.

Do you still prefer to come tot the Dutch Grand Prix by car? Then park your car or motorcycle at Q-Park Mahler (Amsterdam Zuidas), Q-Park Buitenplein (Amstelveen), Q-Park Handelsplein (Amstelveen), or Q-Park Spaarne Gasthuis (Hoofddorp). From these parking lots, you can take Connexxion public buses and be dropped off within walking distance of the circuit.

#### Tickets

• **Park + public bus transport to the circuit:** €51,50 For this price, you can park one car and travel by bus with up to 5 people.
