On Saturday, 22 August, the F1® Sprint takes center stage. This short, spectacular 24-lap race at Circuit Zandvoort lasts around 30 minutes and has no mandatory pit stops. The top 8 drivers earn points for the World Championship, with the winner taking home 8 points.

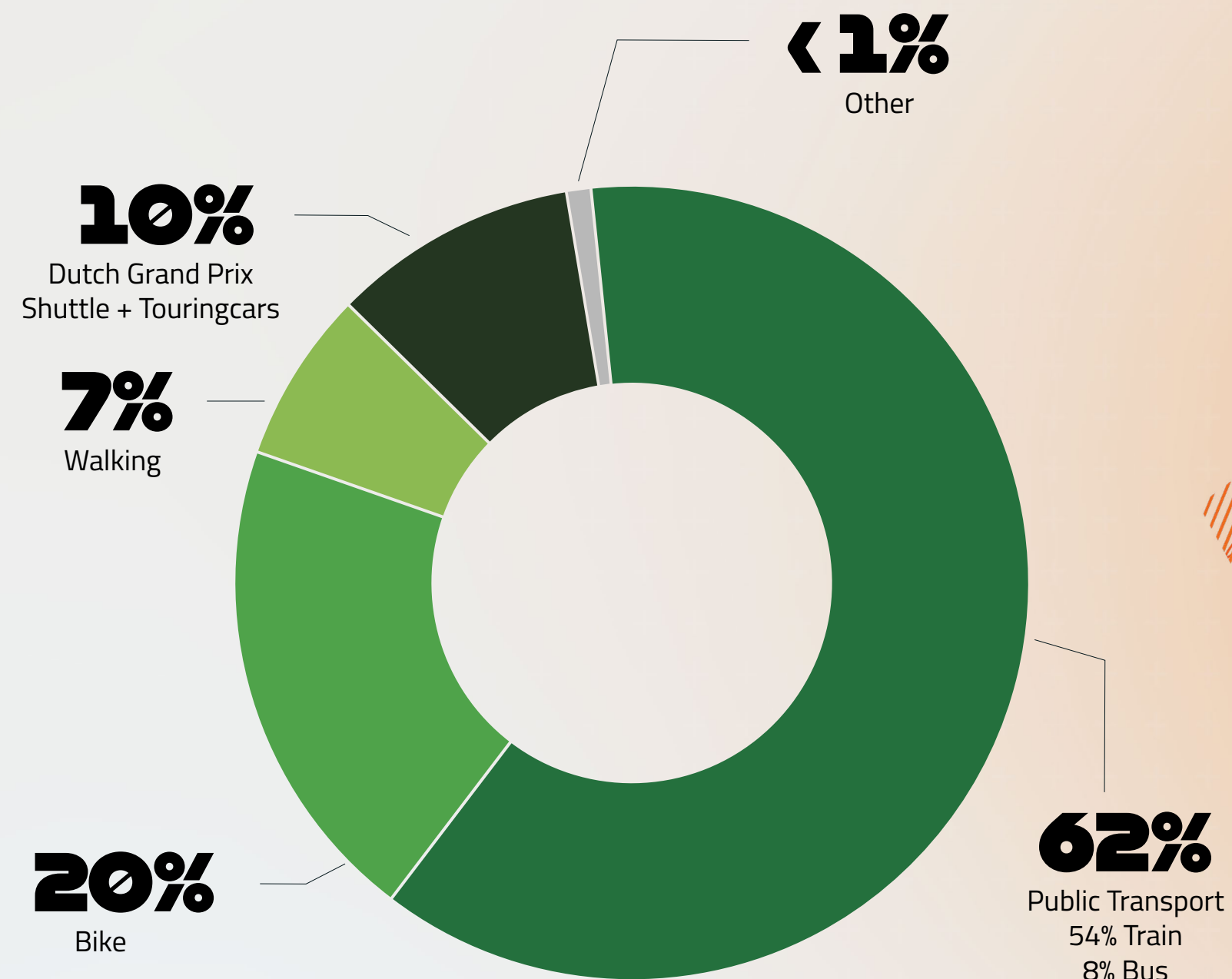

# PARK + BIKE

Take a shared bike ride through the beautiful Dutch countryside to the Dutch Grand Prix. Park your car at the specially designated Park + Bike parking areas in the Zandvoort region, then enjoy a scenic 30-minute ride to the circuit.

After your ride, you can park your bike for free in a bicycle parking area within walking distance of the circuit. Alternatively, you can choose supervised bike parking for a small fee. You may bring your own bike or rent a bike or e-bike.

Bike rentals are available both in advance and on-site at the Park + Bike parking areas. We recommend booking in advance so your bike is ready upon arrival. On-site rentals are subject to availability. It is also possible to create a fully customized package, allowing you to welcome your clients and travel together by bike to the Dutch Grand Prix. # DUTCH GRAND PRIX SHUTTLE

**Do you want to travel comfortably to Zandvoort?** With the Dutch Grand Prix Shuttle, you can board nearby and travel directly to the circuit with no transfers. The cost of a ticket depends on the distance you need to travel, but prices start from €37.

With this travel option, you'll enjoy:

- Choice of over 160 pick-up locations across the Netherlands
- Fixed arrival and departure times.
- Guaranteed seating
- Direct travel to the circuit with no transfers
- Pick-up and drop-off at Boulevard Barnaart, within walking distance of the circuit
- Buses are equipped with a toilet and climate control

# PUBLIC BUS TRANSPORT

Public bus transport is the best option for anyone living in or visiting the Amstelland region (Amstelveen, Uithoorn, Aalsmeer) and Haarlemmermeer. It is also a direct and comfortable option from Amsterdam South and Southeast.

During the entire race weekend, bus lines 300 and 356 run directly from Haarlem Station to the circuit entrance. Connexxion operates approximately 10–12 times per hour, so you won't have to wait long for the next bus.

In addition to the OV-chipkaart, you can now also check in and out using OVpay. This allows you to travel easily with a contactless payment card, credit card, or mobile device (digital pass). No registration or pre-loading is required; the fare is automatically deducted from your account. Please note: American Express is not accepted. Prefer to buy your ticket in advance? That is also possible.

Dutch Grand Prix Day Ticket: from €13\* per person

\* A maximum of 4 children aged 11 and under travel free of charge when accompanied by an adult with a valid bus ticket.

# TRAIN

The train is a popular way for visitors to travel. Around the start and end of the event, however, it can become very busy, even with the maximum number of additional trains and full capacity. Wait times can be up to two hours.

## CONSIDER AN ALTERNATIVE MODE OF TRANSPORT

such as the official Dutch Grand Prix Shuttle (page 8) or Park + Bike (page 7).

With the Dutch Grand Prix Shuttle, you get a guaranteed seat and fixed arrival and departure times, so you know exactly what to expect. Alternatively, use Park + Bike to cycle past the queues.

## IF YOU DO TRAVEL BY TRAIN.

- Buy your ticket in advance or check in with your OV-chipkaart, contactless payment card, or credit card (except AMEX)
- Leave plenty of time to ensure you don't miss any of the race program
- Expect long queues when leaving and consider staying on-site after the race to enjoy the Fanzone or the activities in the center of Zandvoort
- Check the NS app for current travel information

# PARK + RIDE

During the Dutch Grand Prix, Zandvoort and the surrounding municipalities are not accessible by car or motorcycle due to limited parking. A better option is to choose one of the sustainable transport options. Roads to Zandvoort will be closed until Monday, 24 August, 05:00.

If you still want to drive to the Dutch Grand Prix:  
Park your car or motorcycle at Q-Park Mahler (Amsterdam Zuidas), Q-Park Handelsplein (Amstelveen), or Q-Park Spaarne Gasthuis (Hoofddorp). From these parking locations, continue your journey with Connexion public buses and be dropped off within walking distance of the circuit.

## Tickets

- **Parking + public bus transport to the circuit: €55**  
*\*This rate covers 1 car and up to 5 passengers on the bus.*
