

Parent/Legal Guardian Consent Form

Purpose of this Consent Form

This Consent Form provides you, the parent or legal guardian of a child who may be selected to participate in the Activity (defined below), with the relevant details to help you decide whether you would like your child to take part in it.

You must read this Consent Form carefully before you give your consent, to ensure you fully understand what is required of you and your child. You must also ensure that your child understands what their participation involves and ensure that they freely consent to participate in the Activity.

The Activity

DGP RACE B.V. (the **Promoter**) is working with Formula 1 to offer children under 15, who are resident in The Netherlands, the opportunity to ask a question to a Formula 1 driver that will feature in the press conference taking place on 2 September 2021.

Your child has submitted a written question to the Promoter. The Promoter has asked you to create footage of your child asking this question in accordance with the written instructions (the **Instructions**) that the Promoter has provided to you (the **Footage**) and to submit this Footage to the Promoter (the creation and submission of the Footage together being the **Activity**). This Footage may be included, if Formula 1 so chooses and in such a way that we determine, in any and all media including the international feed television signal of the FORMULA 1 HEINEKEN DUTCH GRAND PRIX 2021 (the **International Feed**) as well as any edits, trailers, clips and derivative programmes relating thereto and/or social media feeds.

Confirmations

In consideration of Formula 1 accepting my and my child's participation in the Activity, I hereby confirm:

General

1. I am the child's parent or legal guardian.
2. The F1 Representative and/or the Promoter Representative has fully explained, and I fully understand the details of, my and my child's participation in the Activity.
3. I have explained the Activity carefully to my child and my child fully understands what is required of them and freely consents to participate.
4. I understand that no fee will be payable for my or my child's contribution or for the Footage.
5. My child and I will observe all procedures and rules and follow all guidelines and instructions given by Formula 1, the F1 Representative, the Promoter and/or the Promoter Representative in connection with the Activity. This includes adhering to the Instructions in respect of creating and submitting the Footage.
6. If any of the information I have given in this Consent Form becomes incorrect, I will inform the F1 Representative or the Promoter Representative as soon as possible.
7. To the extent permitted by law, none of Formula 1, the F1 Representative, FIA, the Promoter or the Promoter Representative, shall be liable to my child or to me for any loss or damage or injury to my child or to me, or to my child's or my personal property, in connection with my child's or my participation in the Activity.

8. Neither my child nor I will do anything which is offensive, defamatory, or which could bring Formula 1, FIA or the Promoter into disrepute.

Health & Safety

9. I understand that Formula 1 and FIA take the issue of child safety very seriously, and that I may request a copy of the Formula 1 - Working with Children Policy at any time.

Data

10. I understand that all information collected and/or held in respect of my child and/or myself will only be used in connection with my child's and/or my participation in the Activity (and the use of such participation in related material shall be as specified in paragraph 11 below) and in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018 and General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (Regulation (EU) 2016/679). I can find a copy of the relevant Formula 1 Privacy Policy annexed to this consent form.

Commercial Rights

11. I consent to any part or all of the Footage and/or any still images derived therefrom, being used by Formula 1 and/or its permitted third parties, without limit in time, on a royalty-free basis, in any and all media including: (a) the International Feed; (b) any edits, trailers, clips and/or derivative programmes relating thereto; (c) social media feeds, including Formula 1 social media feeds, FIA social media feeds and ASN social media feeds; (d) the Formula 1 website, FIA website and ASN website; and (e) marketing and publicity materials and FIA publications; and (e) international written media.
12. I confirm that I and/or the other parent/legal guardian signing this Consent Form originated the Footage and, where I have, or both of us have, originated the Footage, I or we (each on our own behalf) assign to Formula 1 the copyright and all other rights in the Footage and waive all moral and personality rights in relation to the Footage and I/we agree that Formula 1 may edit, adapt or translate the Footage.
13. I understand that the signing of this Consent Form does not guarantee the inclusion of the Footage in the International Feed, social media feeds or any other media.
14. I have not entered into any commercial or other sponsorship agreement or arrangement with any person, firm or company in respect of the Footage or my or my child's participation in the Activity, and will not do so.

PRIVACY POLICY

In this document, references to “we”, “us” and/or “our” refer to Formula One Management Limited. Formula One Management Limited is registered in England and Wales with company number 01545332 with its registered office being No.2 St. James’s Market, London, SW1Y 4AH, England.

This Privacy Policy outlines the basis on which any personal data we collect, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us.

For the purpose of data protection law, we are the data controller.

Agreeing to our Privacy Policy

By taking part in the Activity (as defined in the Consent Form to which this Privacy Policy is attached), you agree to us collecting and using personal information about you in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

You have choices about the data we collect. When asked to provide certain personal information you may decline, but where such personal information is necessary for your participation in the Activity, your participation may be restricted as a result.

We will hold your personal information for as long as reasonably necessary for the relevant purpose.

What information do we collect?

We will collect and process the following data about you (the “Information”):

- **Information you give us.** You may give us information about you by filling in forms or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. The information you give us may include your name, address, e-mail address, date of birth, nationality, phone number and preferences.
- **Information we collect about you.** We may collect the following information: footage showing your participation in any Activity.

How do we use your information?

We may use your Information in a number of ways, including to run the Activity, communicate with you and in other ways that you agree to.

We may share your Information with our group companies, law enforcement agencies, service providers, partners, people who operate or take over the running of any Activity and third parties that you agree that we can share it with.

We may disclose your Information in order to protect our rights, comply with applicable laws and as is reasonably necessary to operate our systems and protect us and our users.

We may use your Information:

- to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us and to provide you with the information, products and services that you request from us;
- for record keeping purposes;
- to administer and provide services you request;
- in such way as you may otherwise expressly consent to;
- to comply with legal and regulatory requirements; and/or
- for any other purpose that we may notify to you from time to time.

You agree that we will share your Information with:

- carefully selected third party organisations to carry out certain processing activities on our behalf where such parties have the necessary protections in place to comply with applicable data protection law;
- other Formula 1 group companies (including Formula One Hospitality and Event Services Limited, Formula One World Championship Limited, Formula One Digital Media Limited, Formula One Marketing Limited and Formula Motorsport Limited);
- anyone who may take over the running of the Activity, or any Formula 1 group company or subcontractor who operates a part of the Activity on our behalf. Any other organisations who access your Information in the course of providing services on our behalf will be governed by strict contractual restrictions to make sure that they protect your Information and comply with applicable data protection and privacy laws. We may also independently audit these service providers to make sure that they meet our standards; and/or
- any law enforcement agency requesting your Information once we are reasonably satisfied as to the circumstances surrounding the request.

We will disclose your Information to third parties:

- in order to enforce or apply the terms of any services provided to you;
- to protect our rights, property, or safety, our customers, or others;
- to comply with applicable laws and lawful government requests; and/or
- to operate our systems properly or to protect our users and ourselves.

Except as expressly stated in this Privacy Policy, we will not sell, share, trade or license your Information to others without your express consent.

Children

We are committed to safeguarding children's personal information, and to helping parents and guardians and their children learn how to exercise control over personal information.

If you are under the age of 18, we will require consent from your parent or guardian in order for you to participate in the Activity. Your participation in the Activity will only be accepted once your parent or guardian has provided their consent (through signing the Standard Consent Form).

If you are a parent or guardian and would like to review any personal information that we have collected from your child, have this information deleted, and/or request that there be no further collection or use of your child's personal information or if you have any questions about our Privacy Policy or practices, you may contact us at general@en.formula1.com (English), general@fr.formula1.com (French), general@de.formula1.com (German) or general@es.formula1.com (Spanish) (as applicable).

Security

We have security protocols in place to protect your Information from unauthorised access, improper use or disclosure, unauthorised modification, and unlawful destruction or accidental loss. We only allow access to our databases when necessary, and then under strict guidelines as to what use may be made of such data.

Where we store your Information

We may use service providers to help us administer or operate any Activity. If we or our service providers transfer any Information out of the European Economic Area (EEA) or the UK, it will only be done with the relevant protection (under UK law) being in place.

Your rights in relation to your data

You have rights to access, correct, delete your Information or to object to or restrict our processing of it in certain situations. No fee is usually required to exercise these rights, but we may charge a reasonable fee if your request for access is unfounded or excessive. Alternatively, we may refuse to comply with the request in such circumstances. We may need to request specific information from you to help us confirm your identity and ensure your right to access the information (or to exercise any of your other rights).

In certain circumstances, you have the right to:

- request access to your personal information. This enables you to receive a copy of the personal information we hold about you and to check that we are lawfully processing it.
- request correction of the personal information that we hold about you. This enables you to have any incomplete or inaccurate information we hold about you corrected.

- request erasure of your personal information. This enables you to ask us to delete or remove personal information where there is no good reason for us to continue to process it. You also have the right to ask us to delete or remove your personal information where you have exercised your right to object to processing (see below).
- object where we are processing your personal information for direct marketing purposes or where we are relying on a legitimate interest (or a legitimate interest of a third party) and there is something about your particular situation which makes you want to object to processing on this ground. Generally our processing of your personal data is in order to allow us to provide you a service, so we will be unable to provide the service to you without processing your personal data.
- request the restriction of processing of your personal information. This enables you to ask us to suspend the processing of personal information about you, for example if you want us to establish its accuracy or the reason for processing it.

Changes to our Privacy Policy

Privacy laws and practice are constantly developing. Our policies and procedures are therefore under continual review. We may, from time to time, update our Privacy Policy. Any such changes will be notified to you.
