

How To Record and Upload Your Fan Content



Introduction:

This is a guide to help you record the best possible footage on your respective devices and upload. By default, smartphones are not set to record in the highest possible quality- this is to reduce the file size of the footage you record and to prevent heavy battery drainage.

SECTOR 1

iPhone Video Settings



Navigate to **Settings > Camera > Record Video**, here you'll be presented with various video qualities- which ones that appear depend on your iPhone model. Ensure that **"4K at 60 fps"** is enabled. If no "4K" options are visible, then enable "1080p HD at 60 fps". We recommend adjusting your settings back to the default "1080p at 30 fps" once you're finished recording your video.

SECTOR 2



Android Video Settings

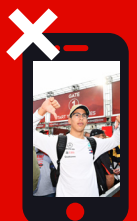
Navigate to the **Camera App > Settings > Video Size**, ensure this is on the highest setting marked with **"UHD" or "4K"**. We recommend adjusting your settings back to the default "1920x1080" once you're finished recording your video.

SECTOR 3



You're ready to go!

Now that your equipment is ready, it's time to get recording! To avoid cropping, ensure your device is landscape.
